

## Turkey and 'Israel' Mutually Decided to Appoint an Ambassador

### News:

Recalling that a dialogue process with 'Israel' began with the formation of a new government in Israel and the election of Isaac Herzog as President, Foreign Minister Mevlut Cavusoglu said, "The process continued with Herzog's visit to Turkey and then my visit to Israel, the visit of Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Yair Lapid to Ankara." said. ### Comment:

During his first 10 years in power, President Erdogan fought against military tutelage, said the world is bigger than five, had the breakthrough against the Jewish Presence of former Israeli President Shimon Peres with 'one minute' you know how to kill, he made his exit, suspended diplomatic relations with the Jewish Presence after the Mavi Marmara incident. During the Arab Spring, he supported the Muslim Brotherhood in Egypt and the opposition in Syria. He highlighted the demands for change in Turkey, the Middle East and North Africa.

These discourses of President Erdogan have been accepted and supported by the people of both Turkey and other Muslim countries, who were marginalized by previous status quo and repressive regimes. He even led to the fact that he was referred to as the Leader of the Ummah.

However, the basis of Erdogan's rhetoric of change in Turkey and its region was the conflicts of influence of colonial Infidel Western states. However, Erdogan succeeded in hiding this conflict behind the rhetoric that the Muslim peoples of the region liked and supported, and he was able to maintain his power strongly.

The failure of the Arab Spring in Erdogan's second 10-year rule and the return to the previous status is the July 15 coup attempt in 2016. The pandemic process experienced in 2020 and 2021 and the subsequent high inflation, as well as the deterioration in the economy, led to a decrease in popular support for Erdogan.

Stuck in both domestic and foreign politics ahead of the upcoming 2023 elections, Erdogan decided to mutually appoint an Ambassador between Turkey and the Extortionate Jewish Presence in 'Israel', as the demand of the United States to normalize relations with the Jewish Presence in the region and the economy to recover.

The fact that 49 Palestinian Muslims were martyred and 360 Muslims were injured as a result of the attacks of the Jewish Presence on Gaza, even two weeks ago and while the issue is still maintaining, this decision shows the point Erdogan has reached.

In addition, emphasizing that it is important for Foreign Minister Çavuşoğlu to appoint an ambassador to develop bilateral relations, he said, "We will continue to defend the rights of Palestine, Jerusalem and Gaza, and it is also important that our messages on this issue are conveyed directly to Tel Aviv at the ambassador level."

His statement is also instructive in terms of showing where they stand on foreign policy.

In the last 3 months;

The President of the Jewish Entity Isaac Herzog, dripping Muslim blood from his hands, was welcomed by President Erdogan on the red carpets in Ankara.

The flag of the Jewish Presence was carried to the Muslim Turkish Soldier.

The grave of the famous Zionist Theodor Herzl, whom Sultan Abdulhamid Khan expelled from his presence because he wanted land from Palestine, was visited by Foreign Minister Mevlut Cavusoglu and a wreath was laid.

The Jewish entity's prime minister and Foreign Minister Yair Lapid met with Cavusoglu in Ankara.

The recent Gaza attack on the Jewish Presence, in which 49 Palestinian Muslims were martyred and 360 injured, was ignored.

A mutual Decision has been taken between Turkey and the Jewish Community to appoint an Ambassador.

President Erdogan held a telephone conversation with the Jewish entity's Prime Minister Yair Lapid about the extortionate Jewish Presence.

All this is due to the fact that President Erdogan is based on a corrupt Capitalist order that prioritizes only interests, interests, power and power in both domestic and foreign politics.

This is due to the fact that Islam, which is the judgment of Allah, does not take reference.

In other words, neither the Will of Allah nor the will of the people was taken as a basis, only the will of the colonial infidels (kuffar) who rule the world today was taken as a basis.
