



You Killed the Ones We Love

While the Chilcot report in the United Kingdom, concluded that “military action was not last result”, and that the US and British governments fought bitterly over control of Iraq’s oil, the debate about the Iraq war has arisen again in Denmark. Here mostly because the Danish equivalent to the Chilcot report was closed down by the government before conclusions could be published.

Comment:

Though defeated minds might find the Chilcot report and its equivalents important, the fact is that there are no “checks and balances” when it comes to western foreign policy, and there will be no consequences for the mass murderers of Muslims in Iraq or any other place for that matter.
