

The Source of the Problems is the Manmade System and the Solution is the Khilafah

President Erdoğan said on an Iftar program in the parliament: "It is clear that attacks on our political, social and economic roots will continue, for we are a country and a nation that is envied. That is why it has become imperative for a change in our country's security concept. We have paid the hefty price of responding to attacks within our borders and Mahram (sacred) zone, too much. From now on we will deal with problems directly from their sources and look for solutions there."

Rasullallah (saw) said: «السُّلْطَانُ ظِلُّ اللَّهِ فِي الْأَرْضِ يَأْوِي إِلَيْهِ كُلُّ ضَعِيفٍ وَمَلْهُوفٍ» **«The Sultan is the shadow of Allah on earth; all of the weak and oppressed takes refuge in that shadow.»** He, who wants the unity of the Ummah, has to implement the Islamic life with the Khilafah Rashidah (righteous Caliphate).
