

## Yemen faces the world's worst famine in 100 years as it is under attack by the World's Worst Rulers in the Absence of the Khilafah

### News:

On the 15th of October 2018 the BBC reported that Yemen is facing the worst famine the world has ever known in 100 years. As many as 13 million civilians are at risk of dying from the lack of food in the war-torn country in the next three months. In an interview with Lisa Grande, the UN's Humanitarian Coordinator for Yemen, she is quoted as saying "I think many of us felt as we went into the 21st century that it was unthinkable that we could see a famine like we saw in Ethiopia, that we saw in Bengal, that we saw in parts of the Soviet Union, that was just unacceptable. Many of us had the confidence that that would never happen again and yet the reality is that in Yemen that is precisely what we are looking at."

### Comment:

The catastrophe in Yemen is often termed in the Media as the "forgotten war", however the reality of the lack of insight into the suffering of the people and how the crisis of poverty has gotten so out of control, is result of deliberate neglect and orchestrated ignorance. It is the "ignored war". Ignored by the insincere international agencies that have monitored the region for many years and have seen the death, starvation and suffering of the sick and have only the will to partially discuss facts. It does not use its International Laws against violating human rights to bring any of the nations to account, and like in Bosnia, Somalia, Iraq, Burma and the Blessed Land- Palestine, they help dig the graves of the exclusively Muslim victims. Under the Khilafah, Yemen was a region of the world that rescued other nations from starvation, refugee problems and natural disasters.
