Pakistani Defense Minister Admits: We did America's Dirty Work for three Decades So what Excuse Remains for those who Stayed Silent?!

In a television interview, Pakistani Defense Minister Khawaja Muhammad Asif admitted that Pakistan has a long history of supporting, training, and funding armed groups on behalf of the United States and Britain. He stated: "We were doing this dirty work for the United States for nearly three decades, and for the West, including Britain. We didn't realize it was a mistake, and we suffered because of it. Had we not joined the war against the Soviet Union, and later the war following the events of 9/11, Pakistan's record would have been full of successes."

Not a flicker of remorse appeared on the face of this symbol of the regime as he admitted that the successive governments ruling Pakistan were nothing more than functional tools carrying out "dirty work" for the colonial disbeliever in the lands of the Muslims.
