End American Raj, Establish Khilafah

**As long as Democracy Remains, Military and Civilian Leadership are
Two Sides of American Coin**

On 10 May, the army media liason, ISPR, retracted a tweet that had earlier rejected the government probe into "Dawn Leaks", declaring that the Prime Minister "has settled the Dawn Leaks issue" and affirmed to continue to "support the democratic process." The entire episode of Dawn Leaks clearly demonstrates that both the civilian and military arms of the Bajwa-Nawaz regime are in the pocket of the United States.

In the case of Dawn Leaks, the civilian leadership accused the military leadership of not faithfully adhering to the US policy of forcefully suppressing the Afghan resistance and the Islam loving people. General Bajwa's reprimand of the civilian leadership through the ISPR tweet was not because of his rejection of the US agenda. His reprimand was through embarrassment at being exposed as being less than loyal to the US, whilst having to save face in front of Pakistan's armed forces, which institutionally rejects civilian compromise of matters of national security. However, after much venting and pressure release, in the end Bajwa settled the matter in a way to please his masters in Washington, endorsing support of his fellow US stooge, Nawaz Sharif, as well as US's horse in Pakistan, Democracy.

O Muslims of Pakistan! Do not be deluded by "Toopee Drama" superficial conflicts in Pakistan's politics, whether in the form of long marches, darnay (sit-ins) or Twitter wars.
