Preventing Friday Prayers is an Unforgivable Crime

(Translated)

Under the pressure of the campaign launched by the benevolent citizens of Tunisia against the measures to close down mosques, the Ministry of Religious Affairs (Aqwaaf) announced the decision to open mosques on Monday, 23/11/2020, to perform the five daily prayers with the exception of Friday prayers.

We in Hizb ut Tahrir / Wilayah of Tunisia highly value the effort made by the people of al-Khadra (Tunisia) for the sake of their Deen and the status of their mosques, and we invite them to unite their voices with ours to ensure that the mosques carry out their full role, on top of which is conducting Friday and the congregational prayers, while taking measures to prevent infection from the Coronavirus.
